How to use this guide

On the other side of this flap are symbols that you'll find useful as you browse this catalogue. The symbols offer a quick reference for you so you can scan our range of products more quickly. For example, they provide information about the level of hearing the product is suitable for, and whether a product is hearing aid compatible.



To help you choose the right product for your level of hearing loss we have graded each product according to the following:



Mild hearing loss

You have some difficulty following speech, mainly in noisy situations.



Up to moderate hearing loss

You have difficulty following speech with a hearing aid.



Up to severe hearing loss

You rely a lot on lipreading, even with a hearing aid.



Up to profound hearing loss

You are likely to rely on lipreading. BSL (British Sign Language) may be your first or preferred language.

For example, if you have severe hearing loss you would choose products with three or four bands.



Can be used with a hearing aid that has a T setting and may also be appropriate for cochlea implants and bone-anchored hearing aids.



Indicates that batteries are included in our price where they are required, supplied by either the manufacturer or us.



Indicates a product can be mains powered or recharged.



All dimensions are in this order: height x width x depth.
