### Amplified telephones

Cordless or cordless?

#### Benefits of corded phones

- The handset is attached to the base unit, which stays in the same place, so you won't lose it.
- Cheaper to buy and often simpler to use.
- They go on working in a power cut, unlike cordless phones (though amplification features may not work).

#### Benefits of cordless phones

- Handsets are not physically attached to the unit, so can be used all over the house.
- You can always have a phone with you, so are more likely to hear it.
- You can buy additional cordless handsets to call other members of your household who may not be able to hear your voice.

## Features to look out for

### Telephone amplification

This makes your caller's voice louder. All our telephones have their decibel level written in the text to show you how loud the handset volume is. Some phones let you amplify your own voice too.

### Big buttons

Some phones have larger buttons, which are helpful if you find small buttons fiddly or have a sight impairment.

### Hearing aid compatibility

All our telephones are hearing aid compatible. You need to switch your hearing aids to T and you'll block any background noise. Cordless phones produce a high-frequency radio signal that may interfere with some hearing aids, producing a buzzing sound. Every hearing aid is different, so phone manufacturers can't know for sure if your hearing aid is susceptible. If you get interference on your hearing aids, you will benefit from a telephone that you can plug a neckloop or ear hook into. Interference may also improve if you adjust the telephone volume and the position of the handset.

### Vibrating pads

Some phones have a socket to plug in a vibrating pad. Put the pad under your pillow at night and it'll vibrate to wake you when the phone rings.

### Mobile phones

Mobile phones connect you to friends, family, or colleagues while on the move. If you wear hearing aids and encounter interference when using a

mobile, you might benefit from using a neckloop or ear hook. See pages 68-71.

### Textphones

You can use a textphone to communicate if you are unable to hear on an amplified phone. You can either type or speak your part of the call and receive text back that you can read on a small display.

Two people with textphones can type directly to each other or if you are speaking to a hearing person or wishing to speak your part of the call, you are linked through a Text Relay operator. For more information, see page 118. Textphones also have text answerphones that leave you a message when you're not at home.

### Telephone amplifiers

If you have a standard corded telephone and have difficulty hearing what is said, a telephone amplifier may help by making incoming speech louder. Attach the amplifier either to the earpiece of your handset, or between the phone and handset, if your handset cable is detachable.

### What is a REN (ringer equivalence number) value?

Your telephone line has limited capacity to accommodate telephones, textphones, fax machines and similar items - up to a REN value of four. What does this mean? All these kinds of items (telephones etc) in our catalogue have a REN value of one. You can't have more than a REN value of four on one phone line. So add up the REN value of all your existing products before buying new ones, to check how much capacity you have left.



### PowerTel M6000

The M6000 has good amplification and a very loud ringer when it's on full volume. The product works well with hearing aids as it is excellent at reducing interference. You can also adjust the tone to suit your particular type of hearing loss. The hands-free function is quite powerful, or you can use the Bluetooth facility and answer calls wirelessly from up to 10m away. The PowerTel M6000 also has an emergency SOS button on the back. It will text and call up to five people three times or until someone responds.

If you have a hearing aid with a T setting this product will help you hear more clearly on your Bluetooth mobile. When you hold a mobile up to your ear its close proximity to your hearing aid sometimes causes interference. However, when you use the neckloop you don't need to hold the mobile to your ear, so you won't get any interference.

A Bluetooth neckloop allows you to legally talk hands-free on your mobile while you're driving. Also, the wireless connection means you can be anywhere within 10 metres and still answer it. This means your mobile doesn't have to be permanently stuck in your pocket or belt case. You can always hear your mobile ring because the ringtone isn't being muffled in your pocket or bag, for example. The ringtone is sent straight to your hearing aids through the neckloop. The neckloop has a built-in microphone that you speak into and a volume control to amplify the caller's voice. Unlike with other neckloops you can adjust the length of this one so that it fits comfortably.
